



CIMADEVILA AND TRETTNAK

The originals have been exhibited worldwide–from the National Museum of China in Beijing to the European Organization for Nuclear Research (CERN) in Geneva, Switzerland.



HYBRID OCEAN

CORDELIA NORRIS

From Wilmington's own pool of talent are the magic realist seascapes of local artist Cordelia Norris. *Hybrid Ocean* imagines the consequences of transforming life in the ocean with consumer plastics—the evolution of strange synthetic hybrids. These watercolor paintings engage the viewer in alluring environments only to have the viewer slowly realize the disturbing reality of these new ecosystems.



OCEANIC ALCHEMIES

RUTH AVA LYONS

We continue Ruth Ava Lyons' hypnotic artwork from her *Oceanic Alchemies* collection. Lyons magically restores a degraded reef by applying digital color to her original photographic images, taken at the Great Barrier Reef, and then handworking them in mixed media. Her symbolic attempt to return the coral to its former glory is her statement of activism toward saving the reefs.



LIVE MUSIC RAYMOND JARRETT



This solo artist, playing guitar, performs heartwarming favorites from classic rock to soulful jazz. Hailing from Brooklyn, Raymond has been a part of the Wilmington music scene for a year now.



FASHIONISTA FLASH MOB



Our 670 visitors on April's gallery walk were astounded by the unexpected performance of a fashion show by 5th graders from Wrightsville Beach Elementary School. The inspiration originated in December after Marine Science Program Coordinator Cissie Brooks brought the group to Expo. By March she had organized a school-wide science fair in which the 5th graders presented different aspects of plastic pollution to the rest of the school. One student acted as Captain Moore and explained his expeditions, another explained the five gyres, several talked about how long it takes plastic to decompose, and others the fashion show.


